



We are receiving many children at the present time not just from Guachochi but from another small city in the mountains called Guadalupe y Calvo. Guadalupe y Calvo is now one of the most violent cities in the country of Mexico, the drug lords are dominating the town. Drug addiction and alcoholism runs rampant. Dionysis and Christian, the two newest members of the Lily family, were able to escape this lifestyle.

In an act of both love and desperation, the mothers of Dionysis and Christian threw them out of their home, instructing them to leave to find a safer life. These two boys, ages 8 and 11, left the violent and drug addicted lifestyle of their family and hometown.

The boys began walking. With the help of an occasional ride, they traveled 152 miles from Guadalupe y Calvo to a city called Parral. Once they arrived in Parral they were taken into protective services and ultimately brought to us. With immense joy we took these two young men into our family. Soon after they arrived, the boys began to share their story with us. We were blown away by the great lengths they went to escape their previous life. God truly protects His children. The boys immediately felt like part of the family. When they arrived at the home they were greeted by other children from Guadalupe y Calvo and without prompting began calling us Mommy and Poppi.

While the boys are acclimating well to their new home, they are still exhausted from the long journey. Even today, several days later, they are still taking long afternoon naps and getting well over twelve hours of sleep a night. We are pleased that they feel safe and secure in our home and that we are able to give the opportunity to rest.

Today, Child Protective Services celebrated Children's Day at an adventure park. The kids enjoyed all kinds of rides, games and treats. Every child wanted to go on the rides with Mama. Dionysis and Christian are in love with their new family and home. What an honor for us to be called by God to do this kind of work. It is very tiring, very demanding and very humbling. It is all worth it to see their faces and hearts change after being with us. It is a HIGH and DEMANDING calling. We would greatly appreciate your prayers.
