



Drought Causing Devastation

It is hot and it is dry. In fact it is extremely hot and extremely dry. We live in what is called "high desert". We cannot remember the last time it rained. And it is worse up in the mountains where we have our extension home. A devastating drought has ruined the crops and that means no food. Because of the lack of rain the rivers are drying up. This is contributing to the death of live stock that the Indian people depend on for food and income. It is terrible for the adults. But it is absolutely devastating for the children. Imagine being a child and eating just a handful of corn and a cup of corn drink (called pinole) once every two days. Then imagine your parents, who don't really care for you anyway, leaving you alone for days or even weeks as they go to their drunken celebrations. This is the plight of the abandoned Tarahumara Indian children. This is the reason we have opened our home in the mountains of Chihuahua.

We have received 12 children in the last 2 months. Just last night we received 3 abandoned children. We have reached our capacity in the home we are renting. We desperately need to start building our permanent home. The local government has given us five acres of beautiful land on which to build. Our hearts will break if we have start turning children away for lack of room. Lamentations 2:19 tells us to "Lift up you hand to him for the lives of you children who faint from hunger at the head of every street.

PLEASE HELP US. We are in need of \$500,000 (US dollars) to fund the construction of this new home. We are asking you to prayerfully consider what the Lord is prompting you to give for this project. We cannot do this without the Lord's anointing and His people stepping up to defend the cause of His precious children in need.
