Two months after ANGELITA'S arrival at our Guachochi's extension I came to visit and met ANGELITA for the first time. She came running up to me with a big smile on her face and gave me football player hug. If you would have been there with me you would have probably said: "this a very happy child from a stable two parents home". I soon discovered that nothing could be further from the truth. When Nohema our Guachochi director told me her story I knew that it was only the love of the Lord and His miracle

power that put the smile on ANGELITA'S face. The truth is that she came from a home where her mother totally neglected her. She was sexually abused by her step father and several other men. When she arrived Nohema noticed that there was bleeding on her underwear and was in a lot of pain. She immediately rushed her to the hospital. Unfortunately the doctors did not diagnose her correctly.

Nohema then took ANGELITA to a Christian doctor in the community who immediately recognized that she had venereal disease. She was referred to a gynecologist who did many tests to determine what was wrong with her. They discovered that it was Syphilis. I am sure your mind is crying out; " I can't believe an 8 year old with syphilis!" That is the way I felt also when I first heard it. ANGELITA began to receive the proper treatment. She received two injections every 15 days plus other medication that was given in the house. But the great news is that the Lord healed ANGELITA physically, emotionally, and spiritually through the love and prayers that she received from the staff and the medical treatment!

In last month's newsletter we talked about a boy name ANGEL whose father was in jail for murder. Although he came when it was not visiting hours, he was allowed to see his father for 15 minutes. The funny story is that Angel didn't remember his father and the jailer had to bring every man by the name Sevento. It was a glorious time for both of them. After the visit was over the Jail Manager came up to us and said that he was allowing Angel to visit anytime he wanted.

The ANGELITA who first came to Lily of the Valley home was not the same bright and smiling girl who I met. God can truly change lives! Through Nohema and the rest of the staff praying for her and ministering forgiveness and the love of God, she was totally healed. **Isaiah 61 Says “the Lord binds up the broken hearted and gives oil of joy in the place of mourning.”** He certainly did this with ANGELITA.

There are so many ANGELITAS out there who need to be rescued from such abuse. Would you consider helping us financially? Would you put a smile on that child's face?
