For years we have watched the beautiful, Tarahumara children beg for money and food in the streets of Chihuahua. We have known God has a plan for us to minister to these people. So here we are 15 years later and God is opening doors to minister to this group of people and specifically to the children.

We have been blessed beyond measure to have many Tarahumara children as part of the Lily family. We'd like to share with you about one very special girl who has recently been placed in our care. Her name is Teresa. When she arrived her big, brown eyes were empty confirming unimaginable hurts. We have watched as God has worked a miracle in her life. You see, Teresa arrived three months ago not speaking. She either refused or simply was unable to communicate. Just yesterday as she was jumping round playing she said, “Rebecca y Micah.” Right now as this is being written Teresa is sitting at a table braiding another child's hair. She's making friends and recognizing love is all around her. This little girl who has been shut up in a world of pain and struggle is beginning to heal because God, her Father, has brought her here and she is hearing everyday God can redeem, save, and heal.

There are so many stories like Teresa's we would love to share. Feliciano is a young boy who is excelling in school. His teachers can't say enough wonderful things about him. Beatriz, the youngest child here is a “joy fountain”. Her smile and happiness are contagious. Martha who came to us pregnant through rape is a single mom, excelling in school and realizing God's dreams for her life. In one and a half years in our home school system she progressed from elementary to high school. The list goes on and on.

Praise the Lord! We are so excited to report remodeling will begin at our new home in Guachochi thanks to friends from Juarez, our local church, Shalom, and the teenage boys from Lily on July 11. This will be the first home of this kind in the Guachochi area. We will be primarily serving the Tarahumara children providing a safe home for newborns to teenagers to hear of our Saviors love.

As Christians we do not believe there are mere coincidences in life. God began a work in our hearts years ago and we are in awe as we watch His plan unfold in Guachochi for the Tarahumara children. We are in need of do-

nations for the renovations being done: everything from toilets to showers, bedding, cooking utensils, and a wood stove. And of course, we need financial support.
