Lizath, one of our daughters, 15 years old, and Ramon, a 25-year-old man, who was raised by us, but now is married and living in Guachochi; both experienced a divine rescue from the jaws of death. He sends out His Word and healed them; He rescued them from the grave."

Lizath had been complaining of abdominal pain. Uncle Andres and his wife, Aunt Hilda, took her 5 times to various hospitals and clinics. They ran all sorts of tests. Unfortunately, the doctors misdiagnosed the problem, saying that it was either gastritis or an ulcer. We kept giving her the medications prescribed. One morning she passed out. Her vital signs were very poor. She was taken to another hospital in the city of Chihuahua and was taken directly into the operating room for emergency surgery. In surgery they found a massive infection. One of her ovaries was removed. In the second surgery the doctors planned to remove the uterus.

At the same time that Lizath was in the hospital Ramon was admitted into intensive care due to a wicked man plunging a knife several times into his abdomen. He lost 3 pints of blood and the doctors said "we don't think he is going to make it." When I (Ed) went to see Ramon in Parral General Hospital I could barely recognize him; his whole body was swollen and there were tubes all over his mouth. We prayed the sinner's prayer and the prayer for healing. One week later he was out of the hospital. Two weeks after coming out of the hospital, he and his wife, Adela, were blessed with a beautiful baby girl, Samantha.
