I cannot imagine the fears and terrors of a little boy who has to sleep out under trees with absolutely no adult to guide and protect him, who has been driven to such a point of desperation and hunger that he looks for food in the garbage dump.

But the great news is Carlos isn't hungry anymore. Neither for food or for love! He is a happy member of our large family in Guachochi. When I reflect on the lives of children such as Carlos, I am so happy that the Lord opened the doors for us two years ago to start this extension home in the mountains. The love of Jesus was so great that he would not allow us to be satisfied with merely our home here in Chihuahua City.
