and a BIG BIG table with lots n lots of food and a BIG backyard where we can play football, it's a BIG BIG house, its my Fathers house".



Yes, in having lived in both homes, I can tell you it is wonderful to have seven bathrooms. You might recall that the other home that we were renting only had two bathrooms. The waiting line was really long and gruesome.

We are imparting in these children God's dreams and with His help building their futures and becoming the moms and dads of future orphanages, missionaries, restaurant managers, doctors and architects of the future of Mexico.

It was so beautiful, to have with us, many young men of our first and second generation that are already professionals and living a productive life. At the end of the ceremony we introduced them and everyone was clapping and very moved to see these young adults whose lives were once broken. As a part of the ceremony there were present many of our past time children from Aldama who have now grown up and are responsible productive adults here in Mexico. We had the old ones from Lily Aldama and the new ones from Lily Guachochi all mixed together. I smiled as I said to myself these little ones from Guachochi will soon fulfill their dreams and be like these adults from Aldama.

In our backyard we also had the beginnings of a pig pen “with our little piglet and chicken coop” our hopes are to build a coral with lots of different animals. We also are seeing the beginnings of fully developed ears of corn in our new garden.

Our plans are to raise lots of animals and vegetables. When your backyard has several acres you can do that. I wish you could have been there for the inauguration. We want to thank you for your prayers and financial support. You were and are a part of this important ministry, IMPORTANT in God’s eyes.

As we type this newsletter our hearts are filled with joy, remembering how many other newsletters we sent you saying “pray for us that we can start building” But now we can say “it is done”.
