Carlos hooked up with a drug addict with whom he picked up food from the trash and lived at the trash dump outside of town. The drug addict used to feed him drugs and it was a common sight to see him wandering the streets drugged up. Social services found this boy passed out in the dump when he was brought to us.

This poor seven-year-old made the garbage dump his only home, garbage and drugs his only food. When we met him he didn't hug anybody nor did he make eye contact with anyone. His first friend was Grandpa Ramon, our maintenance man.

For weeks he would scream and yell if he wasn't given at least two heaping plates full of food at every meal. After a lot of love and hard work, Carlos is able to make eye contact with all of us and he is beginning to play with the other children. Carlos is beginning to smile and recuperate strength. He is also showing affection towards papa Marcos and mama Meche, our Guachochi directors. His body has filled out with all the good food. What a thrill to be a part of "The Carlos rescue team" and you too are a part of this team.

It is our desire to show our children the heart of God like never before, to show the peace and joy that can flood their hearts as they meet Jesus as their friend and God as their Father. Perfect love drives out all fear. Carlos will never again have to fear not having food to eat.
