Sitting beside me that day were two families from two other subcultures very prevalent in Chihuahua, the Menonites and the Tarahumara Indians. As I observed these three different cultures: American (me), Menonite, Tarahumara Indian, I was so amazed that three distinct kinds of people could be sitting within two yards of one another. Observing the other people with their distinctive form of dress and dialects, I remember saying to myself; I will never get to be friends with either of these groups. They are just too different from me. But with the Lord God, you should never say never. With Him all things are possible. I am here to praise God today that I am the proud papa of 25 beautiful Indian children and have been given by God many strong friendships with my Tarahumara Indian and Menonite brothers and sisters. Our new extension in Guachochi we are building with the invaluable and incredible help of many Tarahumara and Menonite brothers. It is so wonderful to see the Menonite people dressed in their outfits reminiscent of 18th and 19th century American farmers, bringing huge quantities of food to our orphan children, and building the fence around our new property in the mountains. Our new home in the mountains is truly an example of Christian unity in the midst of diversity.

Please keep us in your prayers as we start this new adventure in Christ. We have had some unpleasant situations. We just remodeled our new living quarters and this past week the entire place flooded. We had some intensive damage. But we are motivated because we know that greater is He that is in us that he that is in the world. The enemy is not happy to see three cultures together in unity to reach out to these little ones. Together we can do it.
