Have you ever heard of a generational curse? It's the concept that in a person's family line the bad influence of addiction, alcoholism, thievery, divorce and immorality tends to get passed on from parents to children to grandchildren and so on.

We have worked for many years with children who have come to us victims of these bad generational influences. We tell each of our children "the choice is up to you. You don't have to participate in and further the bad influence of your family line. You can accept Jesus as your Saviour, forgive your parents, and be a blessing not a curse to your future children." We have had the joy of watching the power of the Lord break the chains of these curses in so many of our children's lives .

Luis is one of these beautiful examples. His father abandoned him before birth. His mother, uncle and brothers were all heavily involved in alcohol and drugs. His older brother died of an overdose. Luis also was going down that path. At the age of 12 he was already missing entire days of school, failing all his courses, hanging out with the wrong crowd and experimenting with marijuana. But "praise the Lord", Luis was brought to our home and very shortly he surrendered his life to the Lord.

He has so dramatically changed that now he wears a suit to church because he wants to look like the pastor. He is loving, active in the church and helpful in the house.

Luis is praying that one day God will give him the opportunity to meet his father and share the love of Jesus. It's beautiful to share that his mother, brother and uncle are also drug free and living productive lives. Truly God has broken the generational curse in this family.
